Seattle, Bake's Place Bellevue, Alberta Theatre Portland, Revolution Hall Portland, The Roxy Los Angeles); casinos (e.g. Ilani, Snoqualmie, Red Wing, Wild Horse); and large concert venues (e.g. EMP Seattle, Schnitzer Concert Hall Portland, Columbia Metropolitan South Carolina, Philadelphia Convention Center, Appell Center for the Performing Arts Pennsylvania, Lake Theatre Lake Oswego Oregon). International events include shows at Picford Live Hall and MZA in Tokyo.

With Andy's following, the majority of these venues are sold out in advance with waiting lists.

## FESTIVALS

Andy and his band are regular featured artists at festivals all over the country such as: the Portland Waterfront Blues Festival; the VanPort Jazz Festival; the Rose Festival Portland; Harlem Days New York; the Tom Joyner Family Reunion Festival Orlando; Minnesota Fatz Family Reunion Festival Augusta GA; Fort Vancouver July 4th Fireworks Festival Washington; Umoja Family Festival Seattle; Bite of Seattle; Taste of Tacoma Washington; Alabaster Festival Alabama; Summer Fest Bend Oregon; Bite of Portland; Women's Empowerment Festival Columbia SC; and many more.

From smaller festivals of a few hundred to large iconic festivals with crowds of 30,000 and more – Andy Stokes does not disappoint.



## MUSIC AND AIRPLAY


In early 2018 Andy's hit song 'Best Day Ever', the first single off of the EP 'Now', blazed up the Billboard Adult R&B/ MediaBase UAC charts and stayed there for a remarkable 25 weeks. The song debuted in the top 30 on both charts, reached the top 10, and made it onto Billboard's Adult R&B Top 50 for the year—making Andy Stokes the first Northwest artist to achieve this milestone. The song was in the SIRIUSXM Platinum top 20, held the #1 spot on the Official Indie Soul Charts for three consecutive weeks, locked in the #1 spot for R&B/Soul on Music Choice, reached #2 on the



Amazon.com contemporary R&B bestseller list, was named the #1 Independent R&B Soul record of the year, and raced up music charts all over the globe. It remains in heavy rotation across the United States and the Globe. Following the success of his first national release, Andy again brought his feel-good, upbeat, Northwest R&B sound into 2019 in a monumental way—this time with a touch of G-Funk. Teaming up with music icon Snoop Dogg and super-producer DJ Battlecat, 'We On Da Flo', is an impressive R&B track that does not disappoint. The song sat in the top 30 for five weeks and has received universal praise from across the country and beyond.

Also released in 2018, Andy Stokes 'Now' EP is a spectrum of feel-good songs that are superbly crafted to immerse the listener in a

soulful journey emphasizing love, life, and relationships. With millions of views and streams of Andy's prior releases, including the 2016/17 EP 'Full Circle', Andy's music will make any true R&B lover swoon. Powerful ballads and funky, heart-pumping grooves place this renowned singer at the top of the list for crowd-pleasing unforgettable performances and demonstrates his well-earned moniker—The Northwest King of Soul Music.
